- Developed mobile responsive websites directly translated from Photoshop mockups using HTML5, CSS3 with WordPress as the major CMS. A majority of custom functionality required by the client was created using PHP.
- Worked directly with project manager to ensure team met completion dates by assisting in assignment delegation based on current workload of Junior Developers.
- Assisted project manager in creating budgets for projects based off of anticipated work load and project requirements.
- Restructured ASP.NET application. This included updating all views to be mobile responsive and updating stored procedures and functions throughout the site in order to fix items that were either not completed by the previous developer or were not functioning as intended.
- When tasked with increasing website sales of ASP. NET application I implemented a URL Rewrite module for ASP.NET websites 80,000+ products in order to increase search ranking, added metadata to headers of products and fed this data into Facebook using a manually added Facebook Pixel to populate the clients Facebook store with products automatically based off of the products visited by clients, and added Google Adwords tracking events to track purchases. When compared month-to-month sales had increased ~200%.
- Trained clients to use basic WordPress CMS and on any custom theme usage developed for their site both prior to and post launch of their sites.
- Lead developer on .NET CORE web application using Entity Framework for a local Doctors office located in Tampa. Developed the application alongside one junior developer. Was in charge of managing the project to ensure deadlines were met. Worked on every aspect of the application from SQL database to final client view.
- Managed and maintained seven virtual private servers including updates and patches, user quota management, and compatibility management for clients in the event that an update to the server caused issues with their sites.
